INSTRUCTION FOR PARENTS

- 1. The sole aim or objective of providing the syllabus booklet under continuous and comprehensive Evaluation Schemes is to develop in children the basic skills of Communication, numeracy, healthful living, (Along with basic concepts of physical and social environment). Life skills pertaining to world of play, work and culture and other social and personal qualities for all round development of their personality.
- 2. This booklet serves the purpose of a guide which can help students and their parents / guardians to consult anything regarding academic syllabi terminal tests and Bi-annual and Annual Exams round the year.
- 3. All the parents must have a first hand report of this syllabus booklet. Before they prepare their wards for any exams ranging from Unit Test to Annual Exams.

- 4. It needs to be kept safety throughout the current session to enable students prepare their exams according to the contents mentioned for various subjects.
- 5. In case the booklet (Syllabus) is lost, the student is required to report I/C Teacher and get a duplicate issued against a cash payment of Rs. 50/-
- 6. The application for leave by the students shall be accepted if the parents have countersigned it. More than 3 days absence of the child from the school, can affect his / her progress.
- 7. The student must come to school in proper time. Failing which, he / she will not be allowed to enter the school premises till the assembly is over.
- 8. A minimum percentage of 40% to pass an individual subject and an aggregate 50% is needed for passing collective subjects.
- 9. The parents should deposit their ward's monthly fee and other funds before 10th of every month. Failing which a fine of Rs. 20/- shall be charged form the defaulters.
- 10. The student must have all the uniforms as recommended by the school and should come to school in clean and proper uniform which must be accompanied with neck-tie, badge and belt which is provided by the school.
- 11. Children suffering from any infection diseases should not come to school till their recovery from the disease.

- 12. Students should not damage any school property. In case any damage, the loss will have to be made good by the Guardian's / parents of the student involved.
- 13. No parents / Guardians should directly go into the class room. If he /she wanted to see his /her child, he / she will have to seek permission of the Principal.
- 14. Parents / Guardians are requested to write directly to the Principal or meet him personally in case of any grievances.
- 15. The home task must be done every day and should be completed in each and every respect.
- 16. The school shall provide time-table to every student of his / her concerning class and parents shall sent books and note-books according to the same.
- 17. The school shall also be issuing notices / circulars for holidays, meeting and other vital activities from time to time which shall be preserved by the parents.
- 18. The parents must visit school at least twice a month, so that they may have a report of their wards and take better care of them.
- 19. The test copies of class test or Unit test of your ward must be duly signed by you daily and if you fail to do so, he / she will not be allowed to sit in the class.
